AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

DESCRIPTION OF SCENE: The scene of this Incident was in the area of [redacted] Allegheny Twp, West Virginia.

SYNOPSIS: On 08/27/23 at approximately 0717 hours I was working a scheduled 2300-0700 shift. I was in full uniform and operating a marked patrol unit [redacted] alone with my partner [redacted]. We were dispatched to a 1 vehicle crash at the above listed location.

On 08/27/23 this [redacted] Trooper arrived on scene and noticed a [redacted] Subaru Legacy [redacted] sitting off the East bound berm. The Operator of Unit 1 was being evaluated by EMS crew and was getting ready to be transported to Altoona ER for further evaluations. The Operator of Unit 1 was identified by his PA drivers license [redacted] as Edward [redacted].

On 08/27/23 this [redacted] Trooper conducted an interview at the scene with a witness that pulled over after the crash. [redacted] related she seen the vehicle go off the roadway and come to a stop which [redacted] pulled her vehicle over and went over to render aid to the operator. [redacted] related the operator related he drove bus for [redacted] and fell asleep. [redacted] related the operator picked up a pill bottle and put it in his pocket and asked if [redacted] would find his eye glasses. [redacted] related she was looking for his glasses and noticed that the operator threw the pill bottle into the weeds.

On 08/27/23 this [redacted] Trooper conducted an interview at the [redacted] ER with [redacted]. [redacted] related he was drives for [redacted] Bus Company and was on his way home from work and he fell asleep. [redacted] was questioned by this Trooper about the pill bottle and [redacted] related he takes 1, 1MG pill four times a day for anxiety. [redacted] related the pills don't effect him while he drives and he was just tired from driving all night. [redacted] related he took all four pills throughout the day and night.

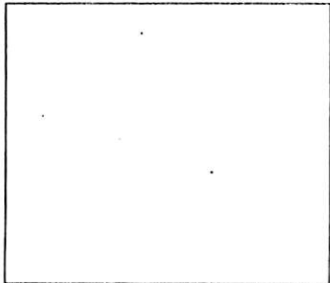

On 08/27/23 ALEQUIN was released to UPMC staff for further treatment due to his motor vehicle crash.
